

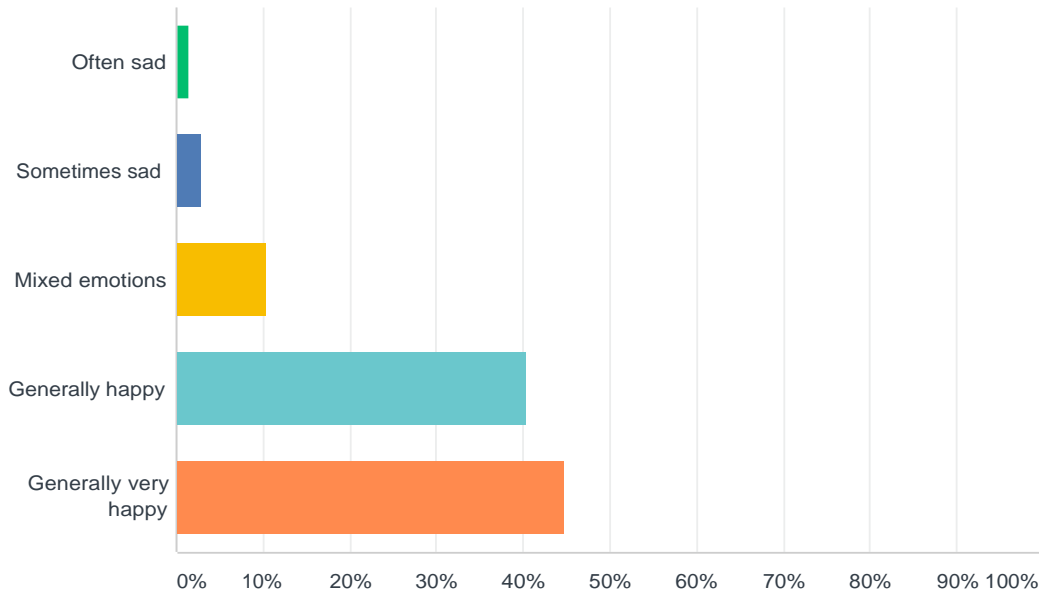

# Q1 How does your child feel about their time at school?

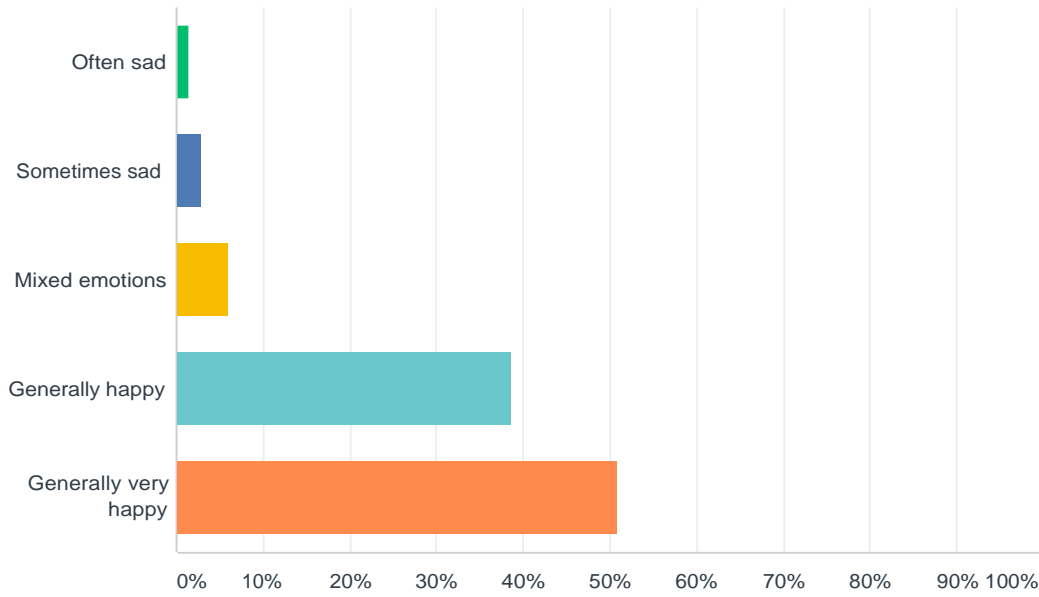

## Q2 How does your child feel about play times and lunch times?

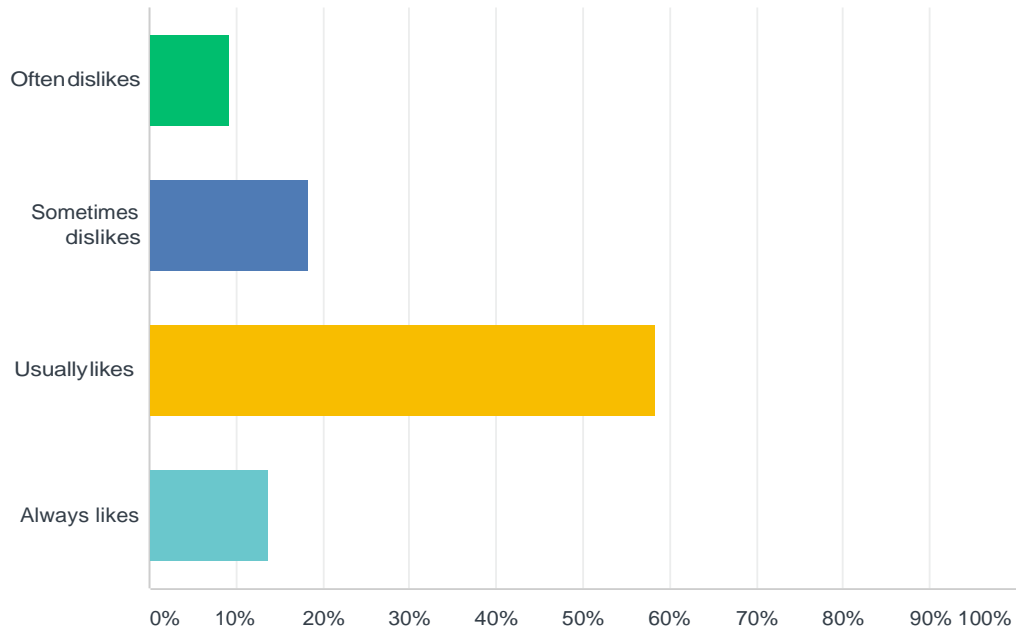

### Q3 How does your child feel about their school meals?

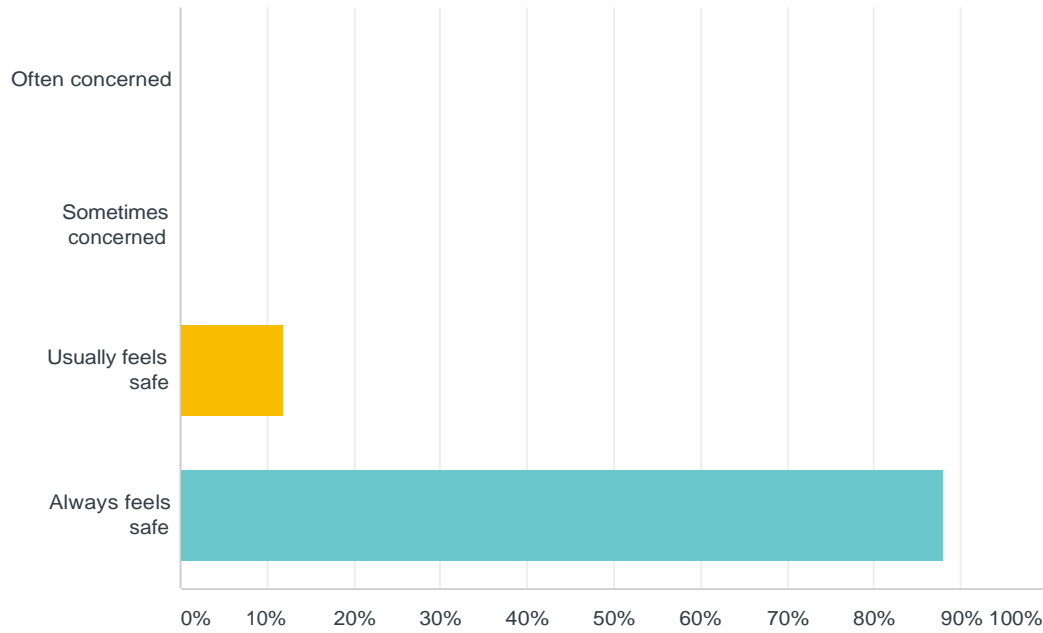

### Q4 How safe does your child feel at school?

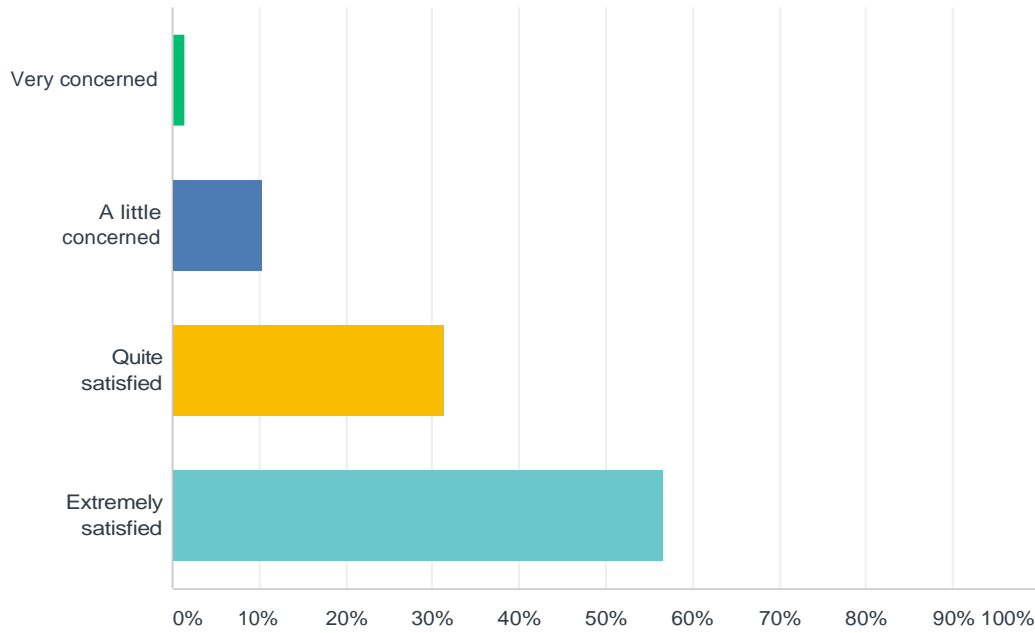

### Q5 How do you feel about your child's progress at school this year?

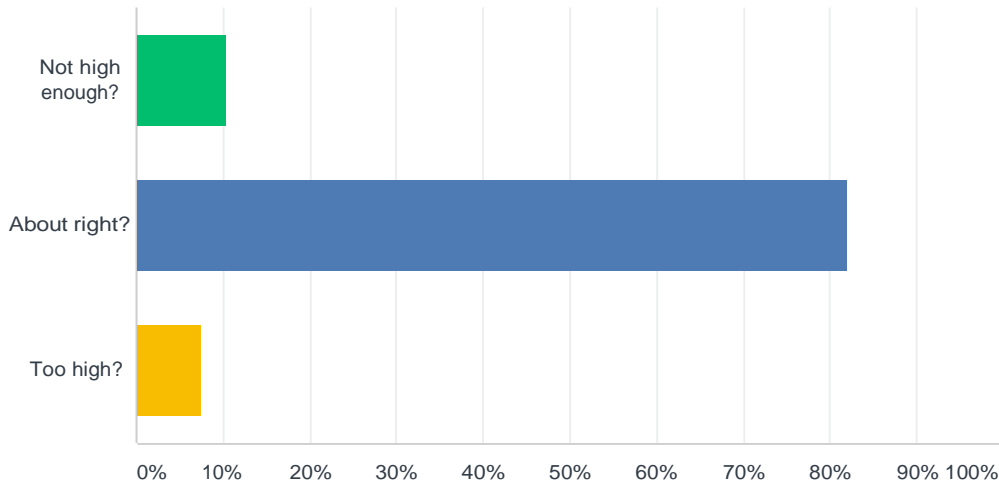

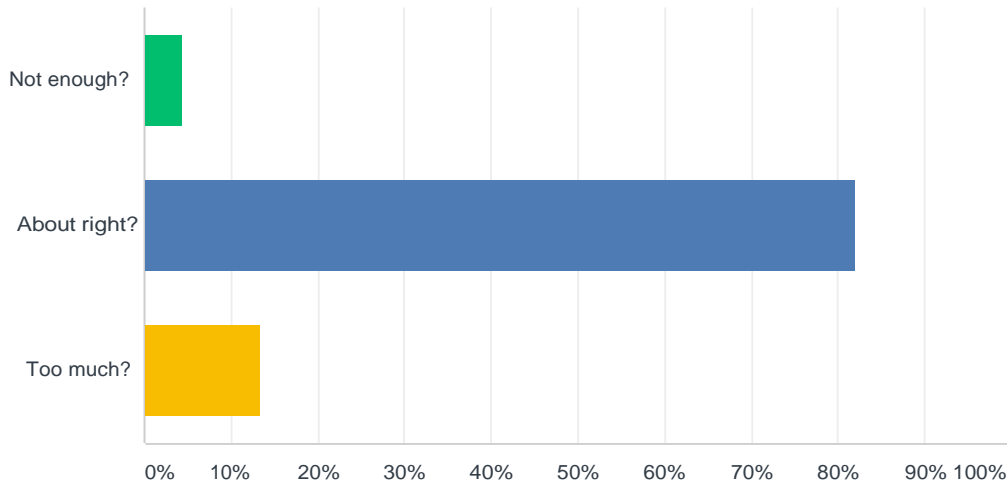

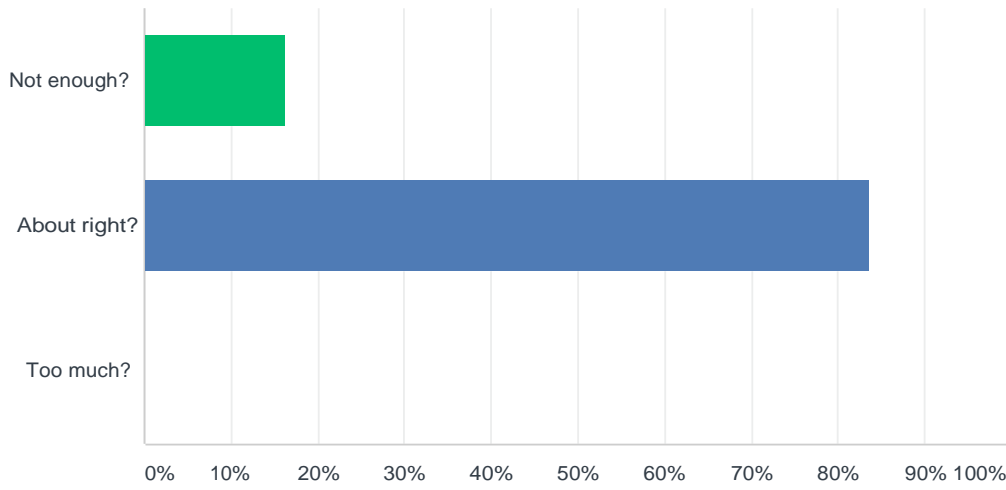

### Q8 Do you consider the information you receive about your child's academic progress at school to be:

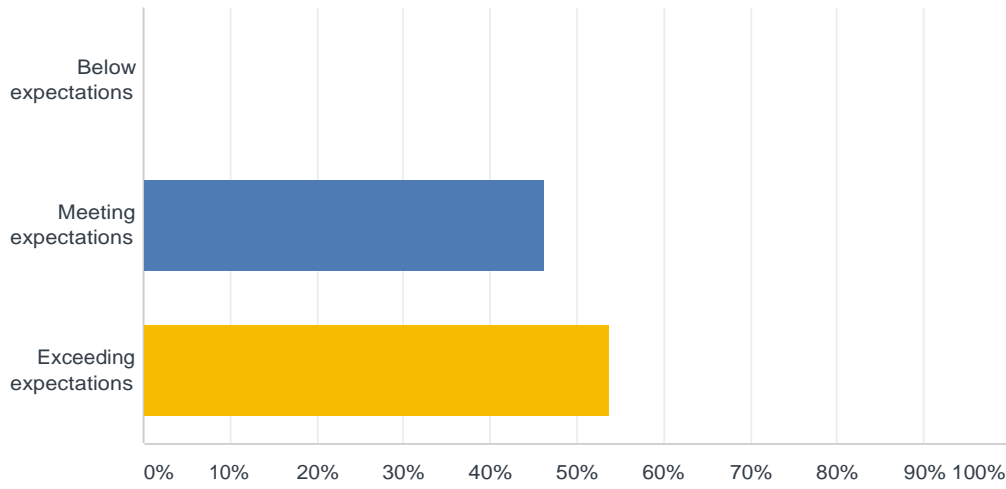

## Q9 How do you rate school leadership and management?

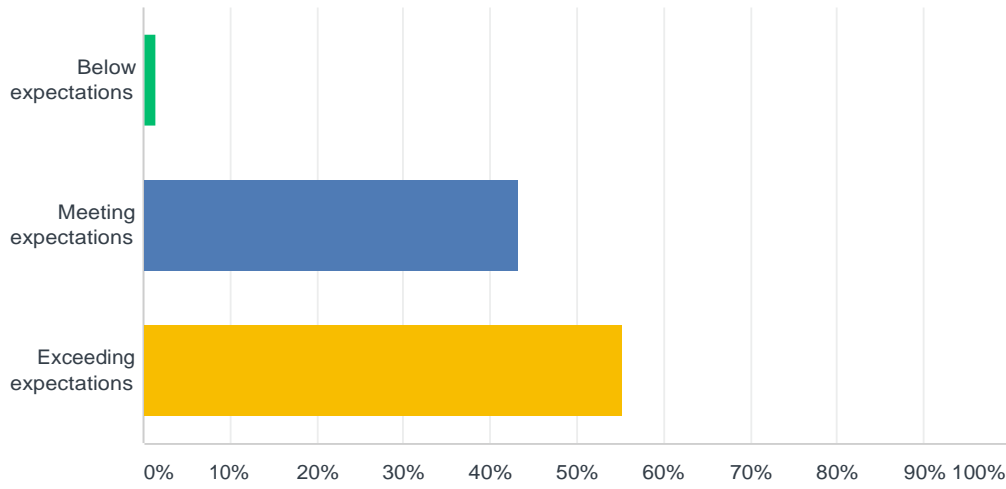

### Q10 How do you rate the teaching standards at Adlington?

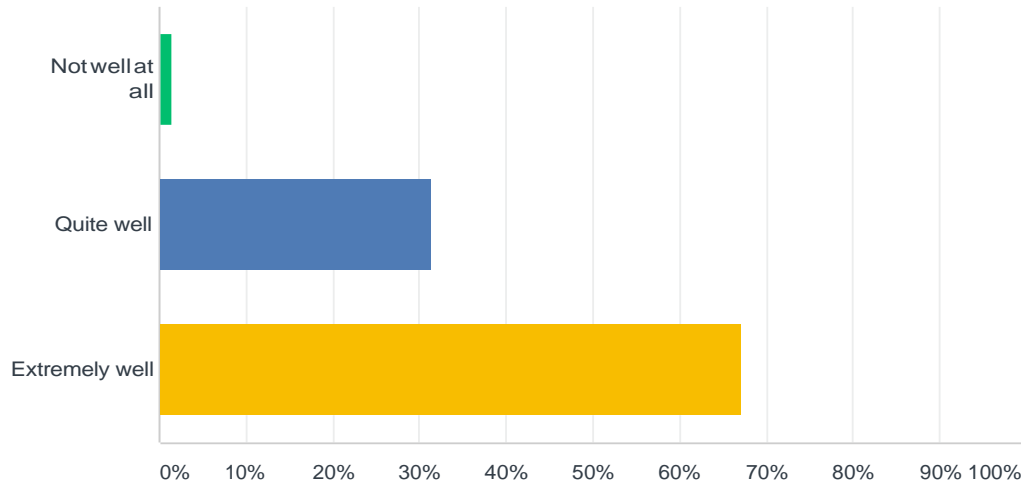

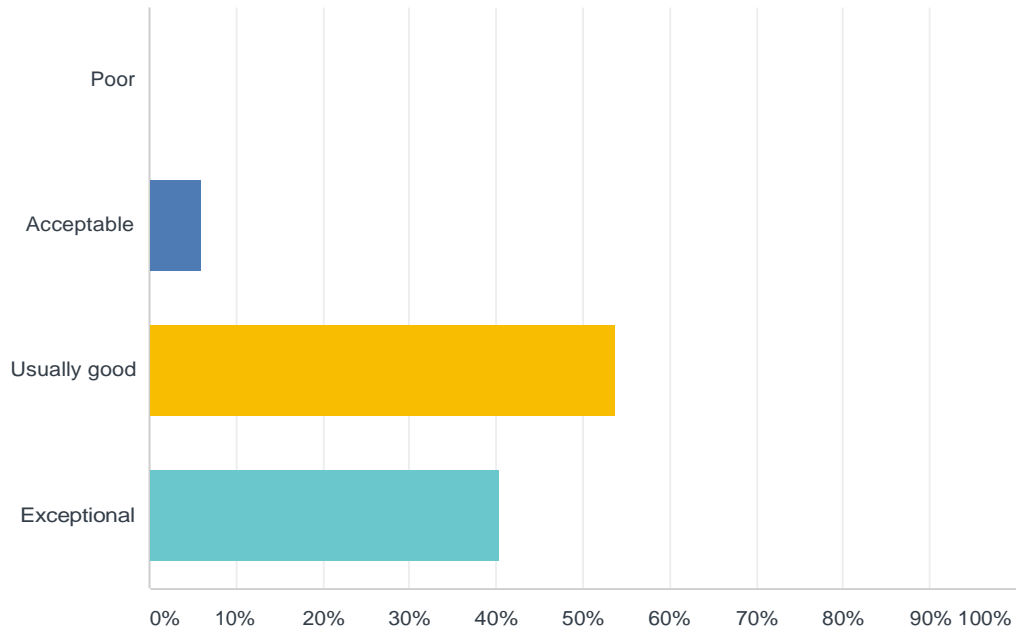

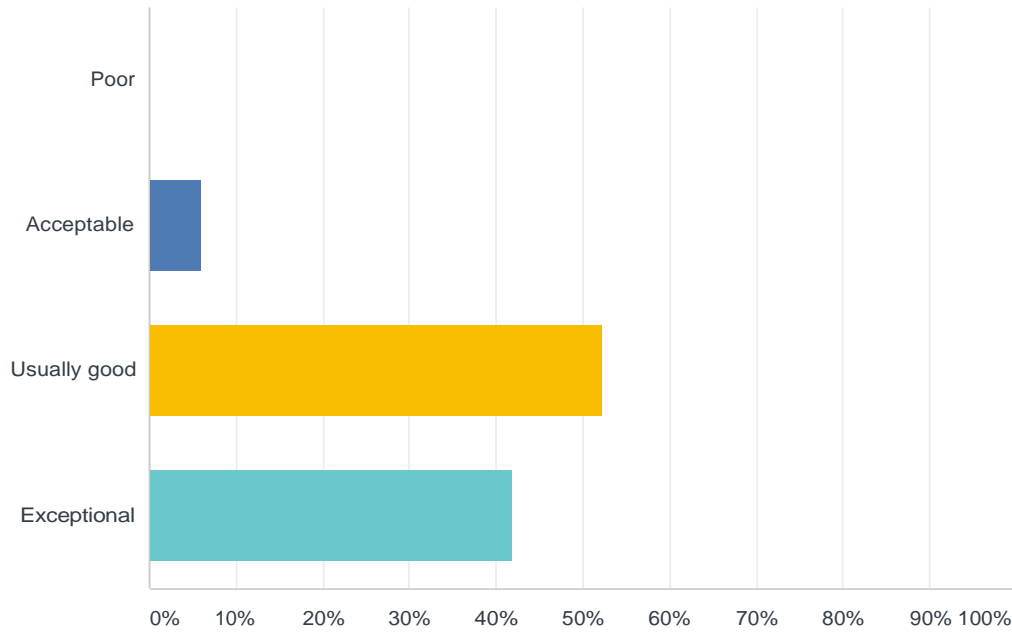

### Q13 Do you believe behaviour at Adlington School is:

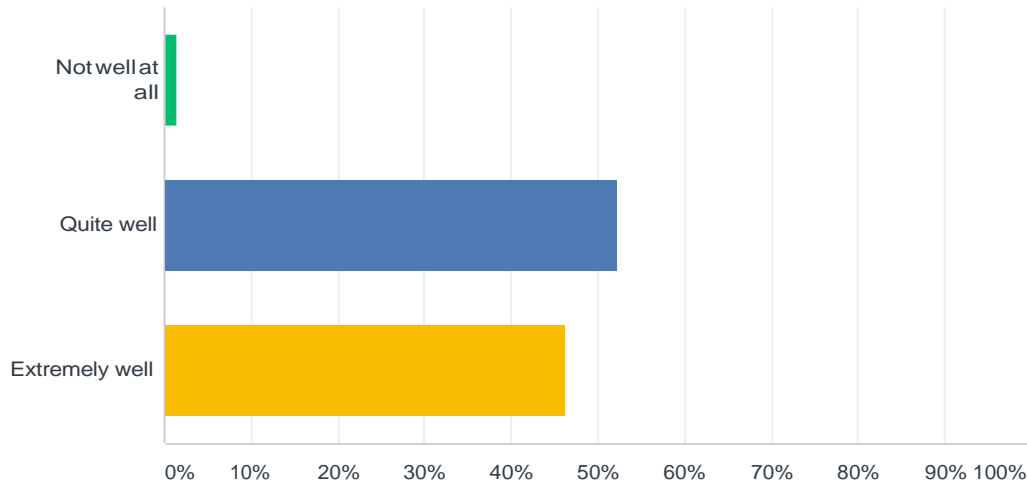

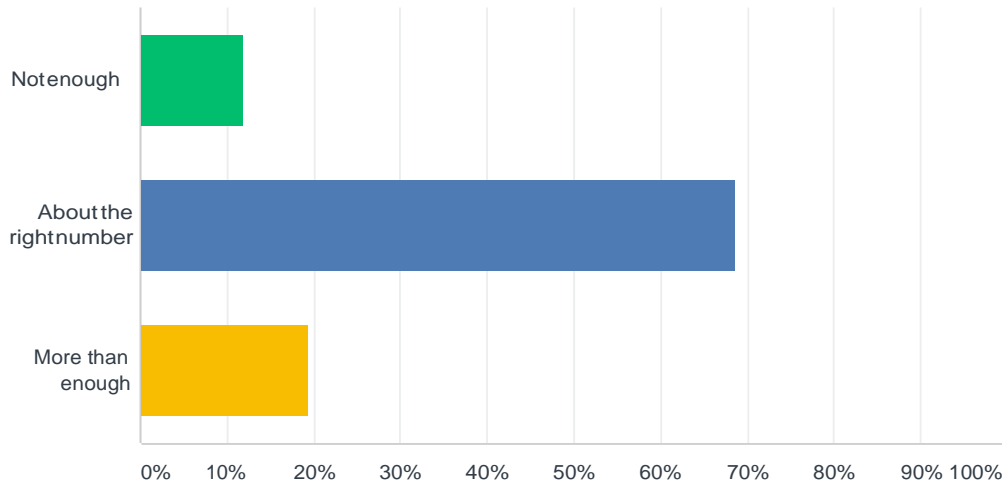

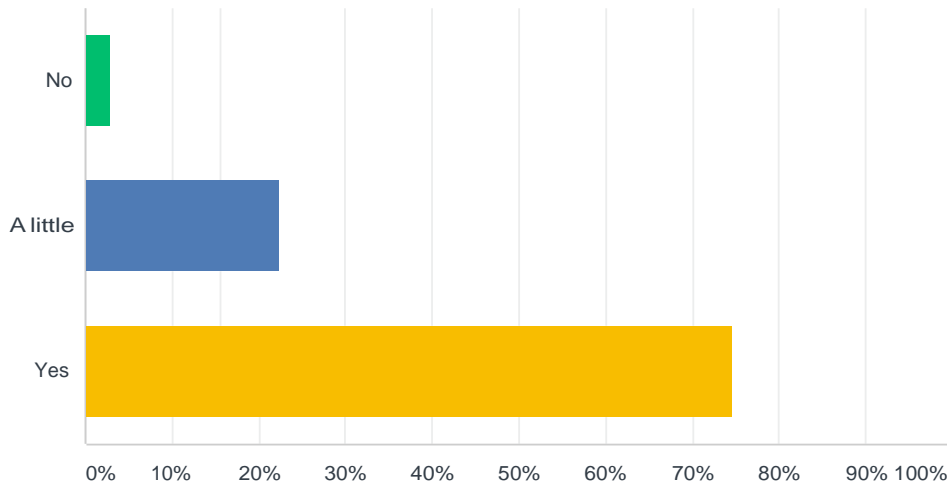

### Q16 Have you been encouraged, as a parent or carer, to play an active part in school life? (PTA, helper, governor etc)?

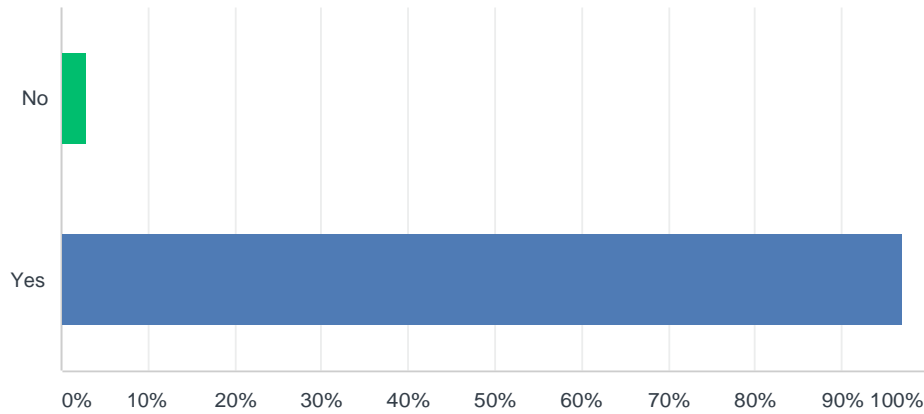
